Winemaker's Tasting Notes Inky with black/garnet hues; Cassis, licorice, green olive and wild sage aromas are blanketed with dusty earth and cedary oak. A dense, sweet fruit center attacks the palate, ripe fruit flavors of blueberries, sweet raspberries and black cherry. The tannins frame the mouth perfectly, fine and dusty.
