## 2006 KRUPP BROTHERS CABERNET SAUVIGNON, NAPA VALLEY

Winemaker's Tasting Notes Dense ruby/purple in color. Classic aromas of creme de cassis, soft licorice, cured meats, smoke and graphite are intermingled with gorgeously sweet blue and black fruits. The wine certainly started life with some tannic clout but as it ages it is revealing great balance. A complex, layered wine that is full bodied, with great texture and supportive tannins.
