Winemaker's Tasting Notes Beautifully focused nose with lots of primary fruit: blueberries, cassis, and raspberries with intermingling licorice, cedar and tar. A savory, complex palate, with very fine, dusty tannins and a persistent finish.

Blend 56% Cabernet Franc, 38% Cabernet Sauvignon, 4.5% Merlot and 1.5% Malbec

Fermentation Average 5 days cold soak and 30 days on skins
