Winemaker's Tasting Notes Aromas of sweet cherries, cranberry, licorice, and plum are intermingled with cinnamon and raspberry-vanilla compote. The palate is beautifully focused and polished; raspberries, violets, lavender, and cranberries give way to fine dusty tannins that frame the mouth perfectly.
