Winemaker's Tasting Notes Complex nose full of aromas of bright red fruits, dark plum and toasted vanilla spice. Silky in texture with a rich and full body. Tannins build to create a beautifully layered mid-structure. Fruit remains forward and is clean and polished with bold, ripe flavors. Finish is subtle but long. Drink now through 2022.
