Winemaker's Tasting Notes Dark inky garnet hue. Complex aromas of boysenberry, maple glazed bacon, toasted oak, toffee, tar, jasmine, orange peel and subtle earthy notes. Flavors of blackberry, white pepper, toasted almond, vanilla, caramelized oak, hickory, plum, roasted meats and baker's chocolate excite the senses. Tannins are fleshy and concentrated in the lengthy, elegant finish. Drink now through 2025.
