Winemaker's Tasting Notes Ruby garnet in color, with inviting aromatic complexity. Layers of ripe cherry, cigar spice, water chestnut, sage, jasmine, raspberry and toasted French oak lift from the glass. The palate is round, satin-like and full of flavors consisting of cherry cola, mocha, cedar spice, cherry, Play-Doh, clay and well-integrated caramelized oak. The finish is smooth, polished and lasts over 40 seconds. Drink now through 2022.
