Winemaker's Tasting Notes Inky black in color with layered aromas of crème de cassis, ripe blackberry, cocoa, white pepper, vanillin, caramel and toasted French oak. The palate is flush, round and full of vibrancy. Ripe black cherry, dark chocolate, blueberry and integrated caramelized oak give way to a powerful, expressive and persistent finish. Crafted from Dr. Krupp's favorite block of Stagecoach Vineyard fruit, M5 is truly a classic Cabernet Sauvignon. Drink now through 2032.
