Winemaker's Tasting Notes Paying tribute to the ancient art of dowsing that made Stagecoach Vineyard and Krupp Brothers possible, this wine evokes the mystical powers of its namesake. Brimming with black currant, boysenberry and anise, the 2013 Water Witch displays vibrant flavors of bright cherry, mocha, blueberry and caramelized oak. A lush mid palate, balanced acidity and fine-grained tannin culminate in a rich, elegant finish. Pair with roasted lamb with braised white beans in lamb ragu and pomegranate pork tenderloin. Drink now through 2030.
