About Krupp Brothers

- ❖ Owned by brothers Dr. Jan Krupp and Bart Krupp
- ❖ Family developed and owns three Napa hillside vineyards comprising over 700 acres of vineyard, including **Stagecoach Vineyard**
- ❖ Over 50 top wineries purchase grapes from Stagecoach, including Caymus, Paul Hobbs, Quintessa, Pahlmeyer, Cain, Duckhorn, Miner Family, and more
- ❖ Located on Pritchard Hill, Stagecoach is the largest contiguous hillside vineyard in the Napa Valley AVA
- ❖ Over a half a million tons of rock were dynamited in order to plant the vineyard



Core Wines

- ❖ **Krupp Brothers "Veraison" Cabernet Sauvignon** – Sourced from Dr. Krupp's favorite Cabernet blocks at Stagecoach Vineyard. 3,500 cases produced.
- ❖ **Krupp Brothers "Veraison" Red Wine** – A cuvée of six different grapes from our hillside vineyards: Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Merlot, Malbec, Petit Verdot, and Syrah. 2,250 cases produced.
- ❖ **Krupp Brothers "The Doctor"** – One of Napa Valley's most unique red blends, combining Tempranillo, Merlot, Malbec, and Cabernet Sauvignon.
- ❖ **Krupp Brothers Chardonnay** – A gorgeously balanced wine showcasing our new world fruit, creamy texture, and mountain minerality.
- ❖ **Krupp Brothers Black Bart Syrah** – Named for the infamous gentleman stagecoach bandit of the late 1800s and a nod to Bart Krupp. Co-fermented with a touch of Viognier

Dr. Jan Krupp & Bart Krupp, proprietors

Jan was a San Francisco-area physician with a passion for farming and wine. He moved to Napa Valley in 1991, planting a 41-acre vineyard on Atlas Peak. Soon, the area's top wineries began clamoring for Dr. Krupp's grapes. In 1995, he was joined by his brother Bart Krupp, an astute businessman with a shared passion for great wine. They purchased and developed what would become Stagecoach Vineyard, now one of the most highly acclaimed vineyards in Napa. In 1999, they began retaining their favorite grape blocks and launched Krupp Brothers winery.

Tres is a Napa Valley native who joined the Krupp Brothers team in 2010. He spent the previous six years crafting award-winning wines for Ladera Vineyards. Tres also honed his skills at St. Clement Vineyards, Domaine Carneros, Yorkville Cellars, Robert Craig Winery, and Tulocay Winery.
