Vintage 2003	The 2003 vintage at Stagecoach was distinguished by mellow temperatures and
	an abundance of sun. This combination was particularly favorable to Cabernet
	Franc creating beautiful aromatics and complex flavors. These same ideal clima-
	ic conditions created an intense See Clone Cabernet Sauvignon which provides
	the velvet hammer component of Synchrony.

WINEMAKER'S COMMENTS

Ink-like, purple-black hue: Aromas of cassis, tobacco, vanilla, coffee-liqueur and lead-pencil shavings; give way to a smooth entry and intense flavors of dark currants, black plums, rich mocha, leather and black spice with a purity of fruit and impressive structure; velvet tannins and a full mid-palate matches a long lingering finish. Synchrony is great with lamb, duck and venison. Drink until 2015. Only 1094 cases produced.
