Vineyards	Block I-4 is a steep South facing 3-acre block on Pritchard Hill planted to Syrah
	clone 470. These blocks have Hambright soil, which is thin, rocky and underlain
	by more rock and clay. Clone 383 Syrah comes from a gently undulating block
	called S2B. These 2 clones are blended together to achieve a medley of fruit with a
	little kick of spice!
Vintage 2005	Bud break came early in 2005. The syrah began to open its eaves on March 15th.
	April and May were cool and stormy. Bloom came late in May and the Summer
	remained cool, leading to a long hang time. The vines were thinned during
	Summer, which allowed a uniform ripening during September and October. A
	long, warm Fall contributed to perfect ripening weather.

WINEMAKER'S COMMENTS

A rich reddish black hue gives way to aromas of violets, boysenberries, vanilla and cinnamon. The palate transitions to currants, dark cherries, ripe plums and black pepper. Well structured with polished, supple, soft tannins and a long, silky finish. Great with Pepper seasoned Porterhouse steak, Peking duck, rack of lamb, or flourless chocolate cake with fresh blueberries and cream. Enjoy now through 2016.
