Winemaker's Tasting Notes Complex aromas of blackcurrants, blackberries, cedar, raspberry jam, and vanilla. The palate is full and rich; flavors of black fruits, violets, wild sage, licorice, and earthiness. Great density and firm supportive tannins that lead into a long finish.
