## 2007 BLACK BART'S BOUNTY SYRAH NAPA VALLEY

**Winemaker's Tasting Notes** Deep Garnet in color with inky black tints. Lovely aromas of violets, blueberry, licorice (red and black), and white pepper. Intense flavors of olallie berry and blackberry with lingering hints of red raspberry. The wine coats the entire palate with complex and lively tannins.

**Fermentation** 5 days cold soak, ferment with indigenous yeast strains, 19 days on skins in an open top tank with spontaneous malolactic fermentation

**Barrel Aging** 19 months—65% new oak
