Winemaker's Tasting Notes Dark inky garnet hue. Complex aromas of blackberry, white pepper, toasty French oak, roasted meats, toffee, jasmine and earthy spice. Flavors of boysenberry, soy, vanilla, hickory, maple glazed bacon and caramelized oak excite the senses. Tannins are round, fleshy and concentrated in the lengthy, elegant finish. Drink now through 2022.
