Winemaker's Tasting Notes Dark garnet hue leads to complex aromatics of blueberry, cassis, almond, toffee, sage, white pepper and clove. Intense flavors of bright black cherry, boysenberry, dark chocolate and caramelized oak are supported by a luscious mid palate, balanced acidity, fine grained tannin and a lengthy, round, elegant finish. Drink now through 2030.
