2013 KRUPP BROTHERS SANGIOVESE NAPA VALLEY

Winemaker's Tasting Notes Fresh and lively, this wine opens with aromatic ripe black cherry, raspberry and purple flowers. Richly textured with refined tannins and a touch of acidity that carry through to a lingering finish filled with layers of sage, cocoa and vanilla. This Sangiovese shows classic Stagecoach Vineyard characteristics with a Super Tuscan twist. Pair with braised lamb and penne arriabatta. Drink now through 2021.
