Winemaker's Tasting Notes Dark garnet and nearly black at its core, the 2014 Veraison Cabernet opens with aromas of ripe cassis, blackberry and caramel. The entry is silky and intense with layers of dark chocolate, currants, violets and a hint of vanilla that carry through to a luxuriously long finish. Pair with dry-aged porterhouse steak and black truffle risotto. Drink now through 2038.
