WINEMAKER'S TASTING NOTES

With a deep garnet purple hue, the 2016 Malbec brims with boysenberry, black plum and clove. Medium-bodied with supple tannins and bright acidity, flavors of black currant and dark chocolate dominate the palate followed by notes of allspice. A long spicy finish offers black pepper and graphite. Pair with an Angus beef hamburger with Swiss cheese and red wine braised onions or Italian eggplant Parmesan. Drink now through 2030.
