WINEMAKER'S TASTING NOTES

Enticing aromas of ripe boysenberry, black currant and brown sugar lift from the glass. The entry is plush with black cherry and maple bacon. Balanced acidity and sweet tannins lead to a long, silky finish grounded by subtle notes of graphite and white pepper. Pair with rabbit rillete with grape jam, vanilla salt and toast points or roasted Portobello mushrooms with balsamic reduction and soft polenta.

Drink now through 2022.
