Black amethyst in the glass, this wine unfolds with aromas of blackberry and boysenberry giving way to the delicate fragrance of violet and warm, spicy cardamom. On the palate, the M5 continues to weave its spell, beginning with a resurgence of blackberry and seamlessly transitioning to black pepper, all framed by lush tannins and a full-bodied structure. A luxurious, lasting dark chocolate finish lingers on the palate. Pair with porterhouse steak with roasted mushrooms, cacio e pepe, or Moliterno al tartufo cheese. Drink now through 2040.
