WINEMAKER'S TASTING NOTES

A rich and commanding Cabernet Sauvignon that opens with layered aromas of dark cherry, boysenberry, and blackberry, accented by subtle notes of cardamom and a hint of California bay leaf. The palate is opulent and full-bodied, framed by lush, integrated tannins. Ripe dark fruits unfold in waves — cherry, blackberry, and boysenberry — giving way to warm spice at the center and a lingering finish of dark chocolate. Pair with filet mignon, wild mushroom risotto, or dark chocolate torte.

Drink now through 2043.
