WINEMAKER'S TASTING NOTES

The nose reveals black cherry and dark plum with undertones of chocolate and cardamom. A bright entry bursting with black cherry gives way to a plush, medium body of dark plum and chocolate amid elegant tannins before finishing with a touch of cinnamon. Pair with hanger steak and garlic mashed potatoes, barbecue ribs, or parmesan cheese. Drink now through 2036.
